

ALFRED WEEK RESEARCH POSTER DISPLAY

The Research Poster Display will be held in the main ground floor corridors of The Alfred. Poster prize winners will be announced at lunchtime on Friday, 23 October in the AMREP Seminar Room.

Call for Abstracts

Staff members of The Alfred, Burnet Institute, Baker IDI Heart and Diabetes Institute and Monash University departments based at AMREP are invited to submit abstracts for poster presentations. Accepted abstracts will be compiled into a booklet that will be available for the duration of the poster display.

Instructions for Abstracts

- An abstract must contain sufficient information so that it is a complete report independent of the poster presentation. The text should not contain statements that refer to results or conclusions not presented within the text.
- Abstracts submitted / presented at other 2009 meetings are acceptable;
- Abstracts should be **no more than 300 words** and should include a title, list of author names (surname and initials) and departmental affiliation(s).
- Abstracts should be formatted according to the example available at <http://www.alfredresearch.org/alfredweek.htm>
- No more than two abstracts should be submitted with the same first author.

Notification of acceptance of abstracts will be e-mailed to submitting authors and will include instructions for display of the posters. Each poster will be allocated a display area **1.2m wide and 1.8m high**.
