ELIGIBILITY

Any medical graduate wishing to train as a surgeon or any surgical trainee shall be eligible to apply for this award. The research must take place within The Alfred hospital / Monash University Department of Surgery under the direction of an experienced researcher.

PURPOSE

- ◆ To undertake research in the field of Surgery
- ◆ To encourage individuals who have not previously been involved in major surgical research activities;
- ◆ To fund a study that is complete in itself and not merely part of a major study.

AMOUNT

Up to **\$7,000** (not intended for living expenses).

TENURE

One year from 1 January 2008.
