### **Gastroenterological Society of Australia – ABBOTT 2010 IBD Clinical Research Grant**

**Internal closing date:** 24 October 2009

**External closing date:** 31 November 2009

The purpose of the GESA Abbott IBD Clinical Research Grant is to advance understanding of inflammatory bowel disease (IBD) and its molecularly targeted treatment strategies in order to provide improved care to patients with inflammatory bowel disease. To achieve this, the Abbott IBD Clinical Research Grant will provide a 'bridging' or 'seeding grant' to support novel research projects. Ultimately, it is expected that with the support of this research grant these novel projects will progress to a stage where applicants are able to attract more significant levels of funding outside of this program. Projects must have clinically-focused objectives. Research topics may represent clinical, fundamental or epidemiological research, as long as there is a strong focus on an unmet clinical need in inflammatory bowel disease. The value of the grant is \$75,000 for one year only. To be eligible, applicants must be a current financial member of GESA and be an established investigator as evidenced by previous or present project and program grant funding (i.e., from NHMRC, ARC, NIH etc).

### **Cardiac Society of Australia and New Zealand – 2010 RT Hall Prize**

Nominations are invited for the CSANZ 2010 R T Hall Prize, which was established to recognise the achievements of senior and established investigators. Valued at \$3,000, the Prize is awarded in open competition and is directed towards recognition of sustained and outstanding research achievements of an individual investigator for a coherent body of work, which advances knowledge of the cardiovascular system and its diseases and which is published in a scientific journal or journals. The work must have been substantially carried out in Australia or New Zealand but the investigator need not be a member of the Society.
